Mission Statement:

To improve outcomes of STEMI patients in North Carolina through advancement of emergency pre-hospital care by multidisciplinary collaboration, education of providers and community involvement

Goals

1. Provide free 12 lead EKG training to all EMS providers across the state

2. Increase the % of EMS transported STEMI patients in North Carolina who:
 - a. Have a pre-hospital 12 lead ECG (Performed within 5 min of arrival and hospital activation within 10)
 - b. Have Door-Needle of < 30 min
 - c. Have FMC- PCI of < 90 min

3. Improve mutual data sharing between EMS and hospitals.
(measured by survey)

Operational

- Improve the interfacility process.
 - Standard boarding pass
 - Establish protocol guidelines/destination
 - Systems to review during 2012 NCCEP
 - Policy for EKG with 5 minutes
 - Increase the percent of patients receiving EKG's
- Ride the Wave

Data Sharing

- Mapping of the different hospitals and EMS systems is still in the process. Survey Data will provide the required data to complete the mapping process.
- Improved data sharing between hospitals and EMS systems
- Usable PREMIS Data
- More systems are measuring the time different increments—1) s/s2B, 2) EMD2B 3) FMC2B
- RACE to have ability to review PREMIS data

Education

- The BLS 12 lead training PowerPoint was released for all level providers.
- Next: Developing the ALS 12 lead training PowerPoint for release.
- Next: Development of the 12 lead Train-the-Trainer

Statewide Surveys

- Surveys are going out to hospitals and EMS systems across the state.
- Information will be used to determine the needs of the state.
